**ORDER**

Due to the underlying nature of this action, Petitioner requests expedited responses from Respondents and the court's resolution of this matter by the end of the week. The court grants, in part, Petitioner's Motion to Expedite and sets the following schedule.

- Respondents must file responses to the following filings no later than 11 a.m. Friday, April 10, 2020.
  - Petitioner's Petition in Quo Warranto and
  - Petitioner's Memorandum in Support.
- Petitioner may file a reply by 5 p.m. Friday, April 10, 2020.
- The court will hold oral argument by electronic means in this matter at 9 a.m. Saturday, April 11, 2020.
  - The court will provide the parties with directions for oral argument by subsequent order.
  - The clerk of the appellate courts will provide notice with information about public viewing of the argument by electronic means.


The court will not consider any requests for extensions of this schedule.

The court has considered and denies Petitioner's Motion for Ex Parte Disposition.

Because Petitioner's allegations may implicate K.S.A. 75-764 and Supreme Court Rule 11.01 (2019 Kan. S. Ct. R. 69), the court by separate order will provide the Kansas Attorney General notice of this action and an opportunity to respond. Any such response is due no later than 11 a.m. Friday, April 10, 2020.
